Happy New Year

We do hope you had a good Christmas and want to wish you every blessing for this New Year.

The last few months of 2024 went well for MAST. Hannah has completed her training to be a Walk Through the Bible Presenter and hopes to be able to deliver her first Old Testament R.E lessons later this year. Hannah was able to conclude her Collective Worship series on stories from the Old Testament in a number of her schools and in those schools has now started a series on the New Testament. It is wonderful to see the children's knowledge and understanding of the bible growing. During the run up to Christmas, Hannah once again delivered the Elizabeth's story presentation in a few more schools which she hadn't visited with the presentation last year. And she used the Elizabeth's story presentation as part of the Schools Together Christmas Event for Hartington and Biggin schools. In the other schools, Hannah delivered Collective Worship using the book 'The Christmas Promise'. It has been such a joy and privilege to be able to share the account of the Birth of Jesus and the real meaning of Christmas with so many children this year.

Chloe had the joy of visiting 2 new schools last term and had the warmest welcome into both. She delivered the Walk Through the Bible programme at 2 schools in Matlock, they both had the Old Testament programme. It's always a joy to see their faces when they've completed all 5 weeks having learnt 40 stories. Chloe also enjoyed sharing an adapted version of Hannah's 'Elizabeth story' to use as a Collective Worship towards the end of the term to whole schools and used 'The Christmas Promise' in the infant schools.

Chloe also had the privilege of working alongside her church where they welcomed in around 150 children over 2 days to give them the 'Christmas Experience'.

- For everyone who supports MAST in prayer and financially.

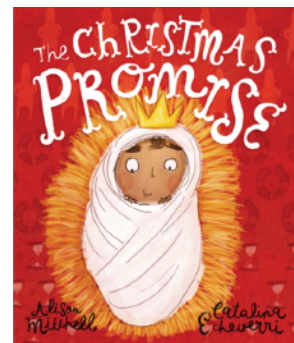
Prayer

The schools were very appreciative of these gifts and we hope that as they are read in schools, the children would be reminded of the message they heard during our Collective Worship.

Despite the harsh weather conditions at the very start of this school term our school visits have got off to a good start. In many of her schools for Collective Worship, Hannah is looking at stories from the early life of Jesus. And in the other schools she is continuing with Old Testament stories about David. Nearer to Easter, Hannah will be sharing the good news about Easter in her Collective Worship.



Chloe is well underway with teaching WTB to two separate years groups in one school, The year 5 class are having the Old Testament whilst the year 6's have the New Testament programme. Always encouraging when the year 6's remember the Old testament stories from the previous year.

Chloe has also been carrying on her series of 'Real people in Real Places' in Collective Worship, This half term she is teaching children about John the Baptist preparing the way for the Messiah. Next half term she is hoping to use Mary Magdalene as her 'Real Person' to help explain the Easter story to children.
